Resolution No. 2024-06

Whereas, Scott County is responsible for processing absentee and uniformed and overseas citizens absentee voting act (UOCAVA) ballots for all or a portion of elections conducted in Scott County; and


Whereas, Minnesota statute §203B.121 requires that any county, municipality, or school board that is responsible for accepting or rejecting absentee and UOCAVA ballots have their board or council pass a resolution authorizing the establishment of ballot boards which will determine whether ballots will be accepted or rejected; and

Whereas, the city of Credit River will establish a sufficient number of ballot boards that will each consist of two thoroughly trained election judges, from two different political parties, with deputy county auditors serving as reserve absentee ballot board members pursuant to MS §204B.19 to §204B.22 to ensure the tasks are completed in an accurate and timely manner in order to expedite the process of accepting or rejecting ballots.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Credit River City Council hereby establishes City Ballot Boards that consists of a sufficient number of trained election judges and deputy county auditors to perform the task of accepting or rejecting ballots.

Be it further resolved that the City Council authorizes and directs the Clerk and Election Administrator to determine the need for, and oversee staffing, of said ballot boards as needed to perform the necessary work.
