**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A FINE SCHEDULE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL  
PENALTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF CREDIT RIVER, MINNESOTA**

**The City Council of Credit River, Minnesota Ordains:**

**SECTION 1.**

**FINE SCHEDULE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL PENALTIES**

Section 1.

**General Rules of Administrative Fine System**


1. Each day a violation exists constitutes a separate offence.
2. Fines are due to the City within 10 days of the date of the citation.
3. A late payment charge of 10% of the fine amount, with a minimum of \$15, is required if not paid within 10 days from the date of the citation.
4. City may collect unpaid fines by a special assessment to the property when the violation can be identified to a property.

| Administrative Fine Schedule  |  |
|---|--|
| First Violation   | \$100  |
| Second Violation (within 12 months of first)  | \$200  |
| Third Violation (within 12 months of first)   | \$400  |
| Fourth Violation (within 12 months of first)  | \$800  |
| All Subsequent Violations (within 12 months of the first)                               | \$1,000  |
| Code Violations that Significantly Endanger Life or Create Critically Unsafe Conditions | \$200 in addition to base fine amount, total not to exceed \$1,000 |


**SECTION 2.** This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
