
**RESOLUTION 2025-04

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Credit River, that the City Council finds, determines, and orders as follows:


- A. Ordinance 2025-02 is lengthy.

**SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE 2025-02:
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC NUISANCES
WITHIN THE CITY OF CREDIT RIVER, MINNESOTA**

The City Council for the City of Credit River, Scott County, Minnesota, hereby ordains that on the 21 day of January 2025 the City Council for the City of Credit River adopted the above Ordinance.

Due to the lengthy content of the Ordinance, a summary is as follows:

The City Council, to provide more flexibility in addressing ordinance violations on an individualized basis that will be more efficient and effective, the Council finds that an alternative enforcement process is necessary. Therefore, to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Credit River, it is the city council's intent to create a process for the use and imposition of administrative civil penalties that will provide the public and the City of Credit River with a more effective alternative method for addressing ordinance violations.

Ordinance 2025-02 as adopted provides updates and clarifications designed to protect the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Credit River by enabling a fair, transparent and appealable citation process.
