

Summary of Government Center Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting

March 26, 2025

The Credit River Government Center Citizens Advisory Committee (GCCAC) met on Wednesday, March 26, 2025. The members of the GCCAC attending the meeting included Thomas Weninger, Jeff Rosenthal, Steve DeGroote, Brad Hoffman, and Thomas Briant. Council Member Liaisons Jay Saterbak and Abe Zanto also attended. The agenda items discussed, and actions taken, at the meeting included the following:

- The GCCAC reviewed a draft needs analysis and recommendations form for the current city hall building and amendments to the document were suggested.
- A final draft of the snow plowing needs analysis and recommendations to the city council was reviewed and additional amendments were proposed for the document.
- A final draft of the septic system needs analysis and recommendations to the city council was reviewed and additional amendments were proposed for the document.
- Final drafts of needs analysis and recommendations for mowing, tree trimming/removal, and street signage were all reviewed, and no additional amendments were proposed to the documents.
- A final draft of the public works building needs analysis and recommendations to the city council was reviewed and additional amendments were proposed for the document.
- Updated versions of all of the needs analysis documents will be reviewed by the GCCAC at the committee's April 2025 meeting.
