**RESOLUTION DECLARING COSTS TO BE ASSESSED AND
ORDERING PREPARATION OF PROPOSED ASSESSMENT AND
NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT HEARING**


WHEREAS, costs have been determined for the improvements for the 210th Street East and Nevada Avenue Project, all said improvements located within Credit River Township. The properties abutting or having access to said road are proposed to be assessed by the Township. The Town Engineer estimates the total project cost to be \$900,000 including estimated bonding, engineering and legal costs. The total cost of the project costs proposed to be paid by Credit River Township is approximately \$147,250 in addition to any cost overruns.

WHEREAS, said project is to be installed under the authority of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 429, et. seq.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF CREDIT
RIVER TOWNSHIP, SCOTT COUNTY, MINNESOTA:**

3. The portion of the cost of such improvement to be paid by the Town is hereby declared to be approximately \$147,250 in addition to any cost overruns for this project and the portion of the cost to be assessed against benefited property owners is hereby declared to be approximately \$753,250 with the final amounts to be determined by the Town Engineer after bids are received and tabulated.
4. The Town Clerk, shall forthwith calculate or have calculated the proper amount to be specially assessed for such improvement against every assessable lot, piece or parcel of land within the area affected, without regard to cash valuation, as provided by law, and she shall file a copy of such proposed assessment in her office for public inspection. The Clerk shall, upon the completion of such proposed assessment roll, provide the Town Board with a copy.
5. A public hearing on adopting the proposed assessment shall be held on May 20, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. The Clerk shall provide posted, published and mailed notice as required by law.
