



SPECIFIC PARCELS OF PROPERTY ENFORCED BY SCOTT COUNTY


WHEREAS, Credit River Township ("Township") has adopted a subdivision ordinance which requires Township approval of various types of subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires that the Scott County Auditor and the Scott County Recorder not process or record any subdivision of land which has not received Township approval.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF CREDIT RIVER TOWNSHIP AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Township hereby declares its intent to have Minn. Stat. § 272.162, relating to restrictions on transfers of specific parcels of property enforced by the Scott County Auditor and Recorder as provided in § 272.162.
2. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Scott County Auditor and Scott County Recorder, and to record a certified copy of the Township's subdivision ordinance at the Scott County Recorder's office.
